

## MHCA COVID-19 Plan:

- ✖ All MHCA students and staff will have their temperatures checked upon arrival to the building. Anyone with 100 degrees or higher will not be admitted.
- ✖ Students Pre-K3 to 3<sup>rd</sup> grade are not mandated to wear masks but are recommended to do so.
- ✖ Students grades 4<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> must wear a mask until social distancing in the classroom is determined and approved by the teacher. When directed by the teacher, students may remove their masks if they choose.
- ✖ Students will report to their homerooms upon arrival rather than gathering in the Commons.
- ✖ Entry into the building will be limited to students and staff, other visitors and volunteers will need the administrator's approval.
- ✖ All students that have class changes will use hand sanitizers upon entry to a classroom.
- ✖ Students will participate in daily recess and must use hand sanitizers or hand washing upon re-entry.
- ✖ Students will eat lunch in the Commons and may remove their masks after social distancing is observed.
- ✖ Personal water bottles are encouraged, no drinking fountains will be available.
- ✖ Anyone age 11 and over must have a Physician's note on file to be excluded from wearing a mask when required.
- ✖ If a student, teacher, or staff member tests positive for Covid-19 they will be in quarantine at home for two weeks until a negative test occurs. The student can join the classroom via google meet or zoom. The absent teachers will be coordinating lesson plans with a substitute during this time frame.
